AGRICULTURAL FAIR HISTORY & OVERVIEW

August 10 to 17, 2024

The Washington County Agricultural Fair a 501(C)(3) non-profit is *Pennsylvania's oldest* fair dating back to October of 1798. The primary mission of the fair is to promote and advance the interest of agriculture, horticulture, homemaking subjects, arts and sciences, 4-H Clubs and FFA organizations and activities.

Washington County has a sizable agriculture industry.

The most recent US Department of Agriculture (USDA)

2017 Census of Agriculture ranked Washington County

Agricultural Industry as one of the largest in the state.

The USDA ranked Washington County fourth overall

in Pennsylvania with 1,760 farms and the largest by

far in Western Pennsylvania trailing only to Lancaster,

York and Berks County amongst the state's 67 counties.

With a total annual attendance of over 64,000 visitors, the total economic impact for the eight days of the fair is over \$6.7 million.

More Fair Facts:

- The fairgrounds and Expo Center include five exhibit halls, 10 barns, grandstand, show arena, show tent, etc.
- The fairgrounds is active on a year-round basis attracting various shows and exhibits. Almost all these events are "rentals" where organizations lease the facility. The largest of these events is the two-week PA Arts & Craft Christmas Market which draws nearly 15,000 visitors annually. The next five largest events include the RV Show, ARH Gun Show and Sale, Duncan Miller Glass Show and Sale, Family Festival and County Home Show, and All-Clad Factory Sale. Most events occur over multiple days and weekends. The Expo Center hosts more than 365 events annually attracting 74,000 visitors.
- Between the Expo Center events and the eight days of the fair, the total annual attendance at the fairgrounds is over 136,000 visitors. The annual economic impact of just the eight days of the fair is over \$6.7 million.

Fairground Improvements and Master Plan:

- The Washington County Fair Board and Washington County have developed a master plan for facility improvements that will improve the overall look, feel and operations of the fairgrounds.
- Fair visitors have already experienced the new fairgrounds trolley bridge and platform, new steer barn, paving, updated wayfinding signage, renovated Draft Horse Barn, renovated restrooms, painted 4-H Barn, new perimeter wall and fence at Arden Road, new Memorial Brick Plaza, new Hall 3 with restrooms and HVAC, and new grandstand and Hall 2 sound systems.

The planned improvements include:

- Hall #1 HVAC, insulation and restrooms
- New Holstein Barn
- Guernsey, Jersey and Poultry Barn
- Picnic Shelter
- CNX Historic Barn Project
- Equestrian Center development
