The Washington County Junior Livestock Advisory Committee, which oversees the market livestock youth program in Washington County, requires that all steers ear tagged as market steer project animals be properly dehorned before the initial weigh-in. The Washington County Junior Livestock Advisory Committee recognizes a potential for horn re-growth after initial dehorning. All market steers must be dehorned before the initial weigh-in. Any horn re-growth that occurs by fair time will be tolerated. However, market steer project members and their parents/guardians **MUST** sign the following waiver statements.
