CODE OF CONDUCT

When an exhibitor, parent, guardian, 4-H leader, coach, educator or representative acting on behalf of an exhibitor is guilty of unsportsmanlike, unethical conduct or foul language, the Washington County Fair Livestock Committee and the Fair Board may require the exhibitor to return all trophies, ribbons, and premiums, and may suspend the exhibitor involved from participation in shows, sales, or events for a period as judged appropriate by the Livestock Committee and Fair Board.

Persons deemed guilty of unsportsmanlike, unethical, or foul language may be expelled from the Washington County Fair Grounds at the direction of the Livestock Committee and Fair Board.

This rule applies at all times during any show, event, activity, or barn.
